The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter dated November 15, 1996, for downhole commingling of production from the Blanco Mesa Verde and Basin Dakota Pools in the No. 183 Rincon, and from the Blanco Mesa Verde, Largo Gallup, and Basin Dakota in the No. 168E Rincon..

Allocation is approved using the following percentages:
