The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter September 30, 1996, requesting approval for downhole commingling of the Basin Pictured Cliffs and Blanco Mesaverde formations in the above referenced well. In verification of your calculations, it was noted that the current bottom hole pressure for the Pictured Cliffs formation should be 359 psi, not 444 psi.
