The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter dated October 24, 1996, for ~~downhole commingling~~ of the Basin Fruitland Coal and WAW Fruitland Sand Pictured Cliffs in the above referenced well.

Your application states that the WAW Fruitland Sand PC has average daily production of 3 MCFD, with an estimated bottom hole pressure of 121 Psi. The Basin Fruitland Coal is to be completed and then both zones will be stimulated and production will commence. From offset production, its is estimated that the Fruitland Coal will average about 1 MCFD.

Approval to downhole commingle is hereby granted. Production from the commingled zones will be allocated at 75% to the WAW Fruitland Sand PC and the remaining 25% to the Basin Fruitland Coal.
