The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter November 13, 1996, requesting approval for downhole commingling of the Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota formations in the above referenced well.

It was determined, from offset production, that the estimated bottom hole pressures are 871 psi for the Mesaverde and 1007 psi for the Dakota formations. After review, we hereby approve your application for downhole commingling. Approval is conditional on submittal of the allocation factors for this well.
