Dakota -	13 % gas	50 % oil

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**Allocation Formula Method:**

**3 Hour Flow Test from Mesaverde = 1250 MCFD & 0 BO**

**3 Hour Flow Test from Dakota = 180 MCFD & 0 BO**

**GAS:**

$$\frac{(MV) 1250 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV \& DK) 1430 \text{ MCFD}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 87\%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 180 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV \& DK) 1430 \text{ MCFD}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 13\%}$$

**OIL:**

$$\frac{(MV) 0 \text{ BO}}{(MV \& DK) 0 \text{ BO}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 50\%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 0 \text{ BO}}{(MV \& DK) 0 \text{ BO}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 50\%}$$
