**Allocation Formula Method:**

**3 Hour Flow Test from Mesaverde = 470 MCFD & 0 BO**

**3 Hour Flow Test from Dakota = 516 MCFD & 0 BO**

**GAS:**

$$\frac{(MV) 470 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV \& DK) 986 \text{ MCFD}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 48\%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 516 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV \& DK) 986 \text{ MCFD}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 52\%}$$

**OIL:**

$$\frac{(MV) 0 \text{ BO}}{(MV \& DK) 0 \text{ BO}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 50\%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 0 \text{ BO}}{(MV \& DK) 0 \text{ BO}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 50\%}$$
