I do not recall in which quarter section the well is located. The Martinez Gas Com F #1G would be the fourth well in the S/2. XTO operates the N/2 wells. We do have some working interest partners in the N/2. We own 100% in the S/2. Do I need to send notice to the N/2 partners, even though XTO operates. If so, I will get notice out tomorrow. Burlington and BP are operators of record in some of the surrounding sections to Sec. 24, as indicated on the ownership map included with the NSL application. 
