



Dear Ms. Staley:

Reference is made to your application dated June 2, 1998, requesting authorization to down hole commingle gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde and Pictured Cliffs formations in the above referenced well. After reviewing the production characteristic of this well and wells in the vicinity, we concur with the fixed allocation factors established in your application. Authorization is hereby given to allocate production in accordance with the factors outlined below:

<u>Formation</u>	<u>Gas</u>	<u>Oil</u>
Mesaverde	81%	100.0%
Pictured Cliffs	19%	0.0%

Commingled production from each zone must be reported in accordance with these established allocation factors. The effective date of commingling will be the date commingling first occurs.

By Sundry notice approved May 1, 1998, you were authorized to conduct recompletion and down hole commingling operations on the referenced well. Within 30 days of conducting this work, please file a subsequent report (form 3160-5, Sundry Notice) of all operations conducted.
