We had a release on 11/11/2015 at the above location. The fire tube of the heater treater developed a hole due to corrosion. All fluids were contained inside an unlined berm. Approximately 5 bbls of crude oil and 15 bbls of produced water were released, and the majority of the fluids were recovered.
