Station emergency shutdown occurred due to faulty battery charger releasing approximately 6 bbls. of pipeline liquids to the area south of the compressor station.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The prevailing winds caused the release to move directly south of the compressor station property onto the Central Valley Electric substation (CVE) yard. CVE was contacted concerning the release. The contaminated soils will be remediated and or collected and transported to a landfill permitted by the OCD for disposal. Confirmation sampling will be conducted to ensure that the contaminated soils have been removed.
