

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
The affected pipeline (California C [Pecos River]) was depressured to the atmosphere to facilitate the replacement of a section of pipeline that was previously clamped. The section of pipeline replaced was subject to additional leaks due to corrosive factors. This pipeline transports sweet field gas to gas processing plants downstream.

Vent Coordinates: **32.06453N 103.803333W (BLM)**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

This blowdown was in response to a leak on this pipeline that occurred on 12/23/2015 where the leak was clamped. In this instance, the damaged section of pipe was replaced with new requiring that the pipeline be blown down again. A PIG was ran on the pipeline before the blowdown to avoid any liquid release; therefore, there were no soil impacts from this event.
