This release was caused when radiant heat from a flare caused a grass fire. A flowline in the path of the fire was melted and water discharged from the line.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
This release occurred on the west side of the well pad near the flare. Concho will work with the Bureau of Land Management to address the impact to the pasture.
