The combined project area for these wells include the entire Section 28, and the W/2 equivalent of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from these wells listed as part of this application shall be measured and sold from the Wilder Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit A, of Section 29, Township 26 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

The oil and gas production from the wells listed in this administrative application shall be measured with separate meters at the CTB.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

After initial notification, future wells that will produce from the pools and leases approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
