This pipeline leak is in Section 13 [T 24S R24E], which is one section in a fairly large block of State land. BLM will not have any involvement in this leak or leak remediation.

BLM does note that there are may cave and karst features in this area - in late 2015, BLM withdrew Federal lands and minerals in this area [just North of Carls Caverns Nat'l Park] from surface and mineral entry. BLM does, however, have some older O&G infrastructure within the withdrawal area.

BLM encourages OCD and Enterprise to be aware of the potential for drill bores and pipeline trenches to intersect underground voids, and for spilled/leak petroleum and waste products to find underground channels and pollute shallow cave/karst aquifers.
