Over-sprayed areas and vegetation were washed with Micro-blaze and saturated surface soils were scraped up and stockpiled on plastic.

BOPCO had an accidental release of fluids from a poly line just off the west side of the location. The saturated area did not extend beyond 65 feet west of the edge of the caliche pad. Volumes total 46 bbls pw and 16 bbls oil released from which 5 bbls oil and 5 bbls pw were recovered by vacuum truck. An emergency one call was placed and the most saturated soils will be removed from the surface of the spill area to a depth of about 2 inches. An initial C-141 will be submitted. Thank you.
