A faulty transfer pump on the piping caused a leak of 1100 bbls of produced water to leak both on and off location. A vacuum truck recovered 900 bbls of produced water and the pump was repaired/replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The affected area is approximately 750' x 200' both on and off location. Remediation will be completed in accordance with the remediation plan approved by both NMOCD and the BLM.

This is to inform you that Oxy Permian had a leak at the SDS 11 Federal #1 SWD on August 17, 2016. Oxy released 1100 bbls of produced water due to a faulty transfer pump on the piping. The preliminary reports show the leak measuring 750' x 200' both and off location. A vacuum truck recovered 900 bbls of produced water. The release is located in Section 11, T24S, R31E in Eddy County, NM. Driving directions: Go East on NM128, turn south on Buck Jackson Rd and go 1.5 miles, turn west and go 150', take right at the "Y" and go 2.5 to 3 miles to 1st lease road on right.
