A faulty fitting caused a leak of 2 bbls of oil and 10 bbls of produced water. Recovery was unachievable due to shallow leak depth. The fitting was replaced.

The affected area is approximately 100' x 165' on location around the well head. Remediation will be completed in accordance with a plan approved by both NMOCD and the BLM.

This is to inform you that Oxy Permian had a leak at the Federal 23 #007H on October 8, 2016. Oxy released 2 bbls of oil and 10 bbls of produced water due to a faulty fitting. The preliminary reports indicates the leak measures 100' x 200' on location at the well head. Recovery was unachievable due to a shallow spill depth. The release is located in U/L C, Section 26, T22S, R31E in Eddy County, NM. Driving directions: From the intersection of NM128 and C29(Red Rd), go North on Red Road approximately 7 miles to first lease road after Mills Ranch Road, turn left and go 1 mile to location.
