A water tank was struck by lightning that rolled in from a bad storm on 11-6-16. Due to the strike, approximately 1200 bbls of produced water leaked in and around the containment. Vacuum trucks were called in to remove all standing fluids and recovered 1140 bbls of produced water. The facility was shut down and will be dismantled. A new facility will be built on the same pad to the North. Once moved, a 3rd party will begin cleanup efforts to evaluate the release. Further actions will be determined at that time.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

A part of the containment was crushed and some fluids got out onto the pad. Nothing went off pad. We are going to rebuild the battery but on the other side of the pad. Once all equipment is moved we will have a consultant go out and assess the area for any impacts.
