

Gas Allocation

$$PC = (20/185)*100 \quad 11 \quad \%$$

$$MV = ((184-20)/184)*100 \quad 89 \quad \%$$

Oil Allocation

Past Pictured Cliffs has not included oil; however, the Mesaverde has produced a small amount. As a result, the future oil allocation is recommended:

$$PC = 0 \quad \%$$
