EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Hearn's 34 State Com No. 708H Well** (API No. 30-025-43858) to be completed within the WC-025 G-09 S143336I; Upper Wolfcamp (Pool Code 98092) underlying the E/2 W/2 of Section 27 and the E/2 W/2 of Section 34, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 275 feet from the south line and 2,846 feet from the west line (Unit O) of Section 34. The upper most perforation will be located 330 feet from the south line and 2,432 feet from the ^{W/2} east line (Unit N) of Section 34, and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the north line and 2,386 feet from the west line (Unit C) of Section 27. Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than the standard offsets to the eastern boundary of the project area.

EOG is the 100% working interest owner in the W/2 E/2 of Section 27 and the W/2 E/2 of Section 34, and ownership is identical in said spacing unit to the proposed spacing unit. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow EOG to use their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste.

Exhibit A is a Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Hearn's 34 State Com No. 708H** encroaches on the spacing and proration unit to the east.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Sections 27 and 34 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Hearn's 34 State Com No. 708H** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.



Exhibit C is an affidavit from the landman verifying that ownership in the W/2 E/2 of Section 27 and the W/2 E/2 of Section 34 is identical in said spacing unit to the proposed spacing unit. Accordingly, there are no affected parties in the spacing units to the east of the proposed well.

A copy of this application has been provided to the State Land Office. Your attention to this matter is appreciated.




