Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of January 25, 1963, wherein you request authority to complete your Jicarilla Apache "B" well No. 10 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 20, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, NEM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, with 3 1/2-inch ID casing and produce the Lakota hydrocarbons through said casing string as a tubingless completion. We have also received the gas-liquid ratio report requested in our letter of February 6, 1963.

Inasmuch as you expect that the well will produce with a gas-liquid ratio in the neighborhood of 61,500 to one, there should be no production problem or waste encountered by your proposed completion.

Amerada Petroleum Corporation is, therefore, hereby authorized to complete and produce the subject well in accordance with the procedure outline in your letter of January 29.

The Commission does reserve the right, however, to review this matter at any time that it appears waste may be resulting from the proposed method of production.

Dear Mr. Nutter:

In answer to your request of February 6, 1963, please be advised the Jicarilla Apache "B" No. 10, located in Section 20, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, produced at the rate of 3,323 MCF with 54 barrels of condensate daily resulting in a gas condensate ratio of 61,500 cubic feet per barrel. No formation water was produced in the test.
