Reference is made to your request dated May 12, 1989, to increase the surface injection pressure on four wells within the North Vacuum Abo Unit Waterflood Project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on these wells during April and May, 1989. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells.

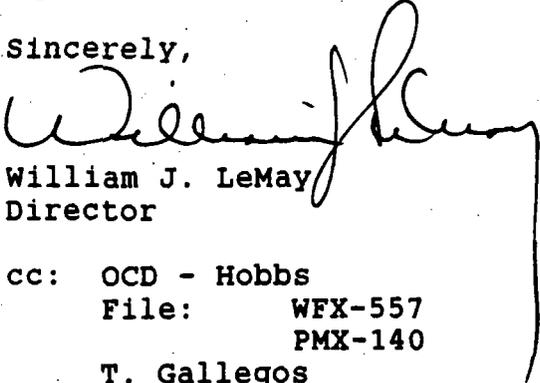

All in Lea County, New Mexico.

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The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
