Reference is made to your request dated June 25, 1987, to increase the surface injection pressure on the E. High Lonesome Federal Well No. 4. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on June 9, 1987. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well.


