Dear Mr. Sirgo:

Reference is made to your request dated July 8, 1991, to increase the surface injection pressure on the West Dollarhide Queen Sand Unit Well No. 135. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on June 25, 1991. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on the well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well.


