Reference is made to your request dated May 20, 1987, to increase the surface injection pressure on four wells in the North Vacuum Abo Unit Waterflood Project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on these wells on May 7, 1987. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells:



All in Lea County, New Mexico.
