Your application to downhole commingle the production from within the wellbore of the above-captioned well was received on August 31, 1999. Your application requests our approval to downhole commingle the Atoka-Wildcat and Illinois Camp Morrow/North production within the wellbore of the Chalk Bluff 36 State Well No. 1, Unit Letter M, located in Section 36-17S-27E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that production from the subject well will be allocated as follows:

Also, please submit your filing fee in the amount of \$30.00 and a copy of the Oil Conservation Division's Order approving this application.


