The above named company is hereby authorized to surface commingle Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas - 71629) Pool production from the following San Juan County, New Mexico leases.

Description: N/2 Section 19, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM

Wells: Meg Well No. 2 (API No. 30-045-30998)  
Unit D, Section 19  
Meg Com Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-30999)  
Unit G, Section 19

Lease: Ricky Lease (Lease Nos. NOO-C-14-20-5390 & NOO-C-14-20-5389)  
Description: W/2 of Section 18, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM

Wells: Ricky Well No. 1R (API No. 30-045-31165)  
Unit D, Section 18  
Ricky Com Well No. 2R (API No. 30-045-31166)

Production from these diversely owned leases shall be determined as follows:

Each of the commingled wells shall be equipped with an allocation meter that will separately meter that well's production. The commingled production shall be determined by an El Paso CPD sales meter located in Section 7, Township 26 North, Range 11 West. The CPD measured gas volume shall be allocated back to each well based upon the allocation meter data. Compressor fuel gas shall be allocated equally between the wells.

The allocation and CPD sales meters shall be calibrated in accordance with the schedule set forth in the application.
