

San Juan 28-6 Unit #170  
(Mesaverde/Dakota) Commingle

Allocation Formula Method:

3 month average from Mesaverde = 360.19 MCFD & 0 BO

3 month average from Dakota = 97.64 MCFD & 0 BO

GAS:

$$\frac{(MV) 360.19 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV/DK) 457.83 \text{ MCFD}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 79\%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 97.64 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV/DK) 457.83 \text{ MCFD}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 21\%}$$

OIL:

$$\frac{(MV) 0 \text{ BO}}{(MV/DK) 0 \text{ BO}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 0\%}$$
