
Attached is a copy of the allocation for the commingling of the subject well. DHC-2581 was issued for this well.

PRODUCTION ALLOCATION FORMULA USING FLOW TEST INFORMATION

San Juan 27-5 #170M  
(Mesaverde/Dakota) Commingle  
Unit P, 34-T27N-R5W

Allocation Formula Method:

3 Hour Flow Test from Mesaverde = 578 MCFD & 0 BO

3 Hour Flow Test from Dakota = 399 MCFD & 0 BO

GAS:

$$\frac{(MV) 578 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV/DK) 977 \text{ MCFD}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 59%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 399 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV/DK) 977 \text{ MCFD}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 41%}$$

OIL:

$$\frac{(MV) 0 \text{ BO}}{(MV/DK) 0 \text{ BO}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 0%}$$
