**AMENDED
AGREED COMPLIANCE ORDER**

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 3 of Agreed Compliance Order 121 (hereinafter "Order"), the Director of the Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") hereby amends that Order as follows:

FINDINGS

1. The Order requires Pogo Producing Company ("Operator") to return to compliance with OCD Rule 201 at least 5 of the wells identified in Exhibit A by September 27, 2006, and file a compliance report by that date.

2. The Order further provides that if Operator returns to compliance with OCD Rule 201 at least 5 of the wells identified in Exhibit A by September 27, 2006, and files a timely compliance report, the OCD shall issue an amendment extending the terms of the Order for an additional six-month period, requiring Operator to return to compliance by March 27, 2007 at least five additional wells identified on Exhibit A still operated by Operator that remain out of compliance.

3. Operator filed a timely compliance report, and the OCD has verified that OCD records indicate that Operator has returned the following wells identified in Exhibit A to compliance:

1. NEL #9	30-015-27327
2. Hondo Singer C #1	30-015-10300
3. DiMaggio #8	30-015-28174
4. Cotton Draw Unit #10	30-025-08195
5. Cotton Draw Unit #33	30-025-08174
6. Cotton Draw Unit #4	30-025-08221

CONCLUSIONS

1. Operator filed a timely compliance report.

2. Operator exceeded by 1 well its goal of returning 5 of the wells identified in Exhibit A to compliance by September 27, 2006.

3. The OCD should amend the Order to extend its terms through March 27, 2007 and require Operator to return to compliance by that date four wells identified in Exhibit A that are not listed in Findings Paragraph 3, above, to meet its 5-well goal for this period.

ORDER

1. Operator shall return to compliance by March 27, 2007 four additional wells identified in Exhibit A that are not listed in Findings Paragraph 3, above, to meet its 5-well goal for this period.

2. Operator shall file a compliance report by March 27, 2007 using the Oil Conservation Division's web-based on-line application.

3. The terms of Agreed Compliance Order 121 otherwise remain in effect and are extended through March 27, 2007.
