Dear Mr. Fesmire:

Pursuant to Division Rule 104.F(2), Mewbourne Oil Company applies for approval of an unorthodox gas well location for the following well:

<u>Well:</u>	Pheasant Ridge "6" State Com. Well No. 1
<u>Location:</u>	990 feet FSL & 2310 feet FEL
<u>Well Unit:</u>	Lots 17, 18, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (the S $\frac{1}{2}$) of irregular Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico

The well will be drilled to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation (Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool), which is spaced on statewide regulations (320 acre well units, with wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to a quarter section line nor closer than 10 feet to a quarter-quarter section line). The S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 6 comprises a non-standard 310.75 acre unit.


The well's location is based upon geologic reasons. Isopachs for the Middle Morrow Green Sand and Middle Morrow Orange sand (the two primary zones) are attached as Exhibits A and B. While an orthodox location was acceptable in the Middle Morrow Green Sand, moving the well to the west of an orthodox location will increase the chances of success in the Middle Morrow Orange Sand. Applicant desires to stack potential zones to increase the chances of drilling a commercial well. **In addition**, while it appears that the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6 has better sand thickness and would provide a better location, applicant does not want to drill in that quarter section due to massive faults nearby.

A land plat is attached as Exhibit C. The S½ of Section 6 is covered by two state leases (Lease B-1398-37 in the SW¼, and Lease V-6950 in the SE¼). The well location is internal to the well unit, and does not encroach on any offset acreage. Therefore, there is no adversely affected offset, and notice of this application has not been given to anyone. (The only working interest owner in the well unit other than applicant (Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C.) has waived objection to the location. See Exhibit D.)



Ladies and Gentlemen:


Mewbourne Oil Company is planning to drill a 12,300 foot Morrow test at an unorthodox location 990' FSL & 2,310' FEL of Section 6, T-21-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Our plans are to commit the S/2 of said Section 6 to the spacing unit assuming a successful completion requiring 320 acre spacing. The location for this well is unorthodox because it is governed by the Osudo Morrow Gas Pool Rules which provide for 320-acre spacing units and requires that wells be located no closer than 660' from the outer boundary line of the quarter section on which the well is located. As planned, the Pheasant Ridge "6" State COM #1 well will be 330' from the outer boundary of the quarter section on which it is located and will only encroach upon the interior of the anticipated spacing unit.

We are planning to seek administrative approval of the location for this well pursuant to the provisions of New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Rule 104.F (2)-(4). If you have no objection to the location of this well, please so indicate by executing and returning to the undersigned one copy of this letter.
