Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a non-standard well location for a well in your San Juan Unit 30-5, to be located 1100 feet from the South line and 1950 feet from the West line of Section 26, Township 30 North, Range 5 West, Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. #46-26

It is our understanding that the request for such exception is based upon archaeological conditions in the area.

Inasmuch as you are the only offset operator, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1, Section (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-110, as amended by Order R-397 paragraph (4), you are hereby granted an exception to Order R-110 Section (c) for the above described unorthodox well location.
