Dear Mr. Macey:

As Operator of the Northeast Blanco Unit, we request permission to drill an unorthodox well, to be located 420' from the North line and 1900' from the East line of Section 6-30N-7W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The proposed Navajo Dam Project prevents a normal well location for this well and it is, therefore, necessary to select a more suitable location for a drilling site.

Section 6-30N-7W is a part of the Northeast Blanco Unit and the new location, as requested, will present no drainage problem to offset operators.

We enclose a location plat for the requested new location.


