In compliance with Rule 104, Paragraph (f), application is hereby made for a non-standard wildcat well location, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company USA E. H. Newman No. 1, Strat Test, 660' from the South and 660' from the East line of Section 31, T-27-N, R-13-W, San Juan County, New Mexico. A non-standard well location is required because of topographical conditions.

Attached is a plat showing well location. Inasmuch as the ownership of all oil and gas leases within a radius of 660' of the proposed location is common with the ownership of the oil and gas leases under the proposed location, no other operators were supplied copy of this application.

While this well is carried as a Strat Test, exception to the requirements of Rule 104, Paragraph (b) is requested because if commercial oil or gas shows are obtained, we will desire to redesignate this well as a wildcat well.

We are now obtaining a rig to drill this well and would like to move on in the near future. Your early consideration of our application would, therefore, be appreciated.

I hereby certify that the above and the attached plat are true and correct to the best of my knowledge.


