Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Hanks Well No. 7, to be located 1125 feet from the North line and 2450 feet from the East line and in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the request for such exception is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the Northeast quarter of said section.

Inasmuch as we received a waiver from the offset operator agreeing to the unorthodox well location, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-565-C, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 3 of Order R-565-C for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
