We have filed 6 copies of notice of Intention to drill (Form 9-331B) to amend location for our Jicarilla No. 3-2, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, previously filed by letter of May 1, 1956.

The amended location falls at an unorthodox location being 415' FSL and 745' FWL of Section 2, T-23-N, R-4-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, it has been moved due to the topographic condition of the previous locations.


