Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location to be located 1515 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line and in Lot 2 of Section 6, Township 24 North, Range 3 West, Undesignated Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. *Clark # 2*

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you furnished waivers from the offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Statewide Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
