Pursuant to General Rule 104-d and Order No. R-110, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for an exception to the well location regulations set forth above and requests approval of a non-standard drilling location in the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully states and shows the following:

1. The proposed non-standard drilling location has been staked one thousand nine hundred and eight (1,980) feet from the North line and two thousand four hundred and forty (2,440) feet from the East line of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. This non-standard location is requested because of the topographical conditions existing on the proposed drilling block.
2. Aztec Oil & Gas Company intends to drill a well at the non-standard drilling location, if approved, to be known as the Aztec-Koch State No. 1 Well.
3. The proposed well will be a gas-gas dual completion and will be within the defined limits of the Blanco-Mesaverde gas pool and an extension to the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs gas pool. A separate application is being filed for the approval of this dual completion.

4. So far as is known to applicant, the following operators own mineral rights on the acreage offsetting the proposed well, as shown on the attached plat:

- (a) El Paso Natural Gas Company ✓
- (b) El Dorado Refining Company ✓
- (c) Sue Turner
- (d) Sam Dazzio

A copy of this application has been sent to them by registered mail with a request that their approval be sent to you or to Aztec for transmittal.

Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests that the Secretary-Director of the Commission grant an exception to General Rule 104-d and Order No. R-110, without notice and hearing, approving the non-standard location hereinabove set forth.




