Gentlemen:

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Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your SJU 32-7 Well No. 16-17 to be located 940 feet from the North line and 2330 feet from the East line and in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

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Inasmuch as there are no other affected offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Section 1 (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-110 as amended by Order R-397, you are hereby granted an exception to Section 1 (c) of Order R-110 as amended by Order R-397, for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
