Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Federal Well No. 14-3 to be located 1225 feet from the South line and 893 feet from the West line and in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, Aztec Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as there are no other effected offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-365-C, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 3 of Order R-365-C for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
