

Gentlemen:

A Notice of Intention to Drill dated July 9, 1957, was filed with the United States Department of the Interior, Geological Survey, Farmington, New Mexico. Because of topographic conditions, this well is located 895 feet from the west line and 1,225 feet from the south line of Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 11 West. It is, therefore, requested that an exception to Rule 104, Part D pertaining to wells drilled closer than 130 feet to any quarter quarter section or subdivision inner boundary be granted. This unorthodox location will effect no lease ownership other than this Company's.

Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat


