Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Jicarilla Well No. 11-G to be located 560 feet from the South line and 560 feet from the West line and in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section.

Inasmuch as you own all leases within a 790 foot radius from the proposed location, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, as set forth in Order R-565-C, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 3 of Order R-565-C for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
