Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox location for a well to be drilled at a point 740 feet from the South line and 790 feet from the East line and in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 18, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, undesignated Pictured Cliff Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.
