Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your McClanahan Well No. 10 located 990 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line and in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 of said section.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, as set forth in Order R-565-C, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 3 of Order R-565-C for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
