Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Santa Fe-Pacific Railroad Company Well No. 1-9612 to be located 700 feet from the South line and 1070 feet from the West line and in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 5, Township 5 North, Range 7 West, NMPL, Valencia County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW/4 of said Section.

Inasmuch as you own all acreage within 660 feet of the proposed location, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104(f) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104(b) for the above-described unorthodox well location.
