

Nearburg & Ingram request administrative approval under Order No. R-1417, Rule 3 (b) to deepen the No. 1 Hawkins (660' from North and 1980' from East lines of Section 27, T. 18-S, R. 26-E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico) from 6260' to 9500' to test the lower Pennsylvanian gas sands. The 320 acres comprising the North one-half of Section 27 will be dedicated to the well if productive. Operations on the subject well were suspended on February 17, 1959.

Attached is a plat showing location of wells in Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Area and ownership in and around the proposed unit.

In seeking approval under Order No. R-1417, Rule 3 (b), it is necessary that we notify offset operators and those within the section in which the subject well is located.




