Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Binson-Federal Well No. 1 to be located 760 feet from the North line and 1586 feet from the West line of Section 17, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 of said Section 17.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, as set forth in Order No. R-565-C, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 3 of Order No. R-565-C for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
