



This letter is a request for approval of an unorthodox location for a Pictured Cliffs gas well drilled in the NW/4 of Section 17, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. The footage on the well is 760' FNL & 1586' FNL of Section 17. We have talked to USGS and Mr. Emery Arnold regarding this.

The location was made where it was because of gullies on either side and because of El Paso's pipeline which lies approximately 50 feet west of the well. The pipeline ~~and~~ trends in an approximate northwest-southeast direction through this part of the section.

A letter has been written to El Paso Natural Gas Company who we believe is the offset operator in a northward direction.
