Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your San Juan 32-5 Unit Well No. 2-26, to be located 1850 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line and in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, Dakota Producing Interval, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said Section 26.

Inasmuch as you furnished waivers from the offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 2 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Dakota Producing Interval as set forth in Order R-1287, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 (a) of Order R-1287 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
