Gentlemen:

We have recently been notified by your Hobbs office that the location of the subject well does not comply with the requirements for a standard location for a gas well as set out in Rule 104 (d). Also, that it will be necessary to obtain an exception to this rule before approval will be made of the Forms C-104 and C-110.

The Britt "A" Unit No. 7 is located 2310 feet from the South line and 1880 feet from the West line of Section 6-20S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well was drilled to test the Ellenburger formation; however, this zone was found to be non-productive and the well was plugged back and completed in the McKee gas zone. The location of this well was based on Rule 104 (c). ✓


We ask that the Secretary Director consider this as our application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 104 (d).


Gentlemen:
